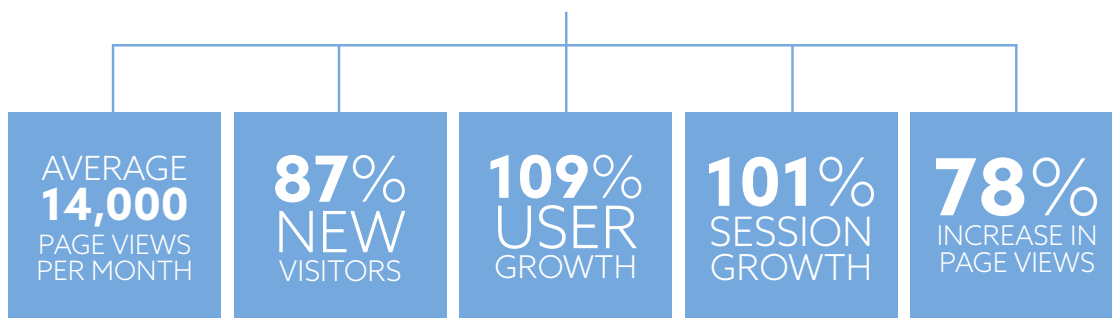

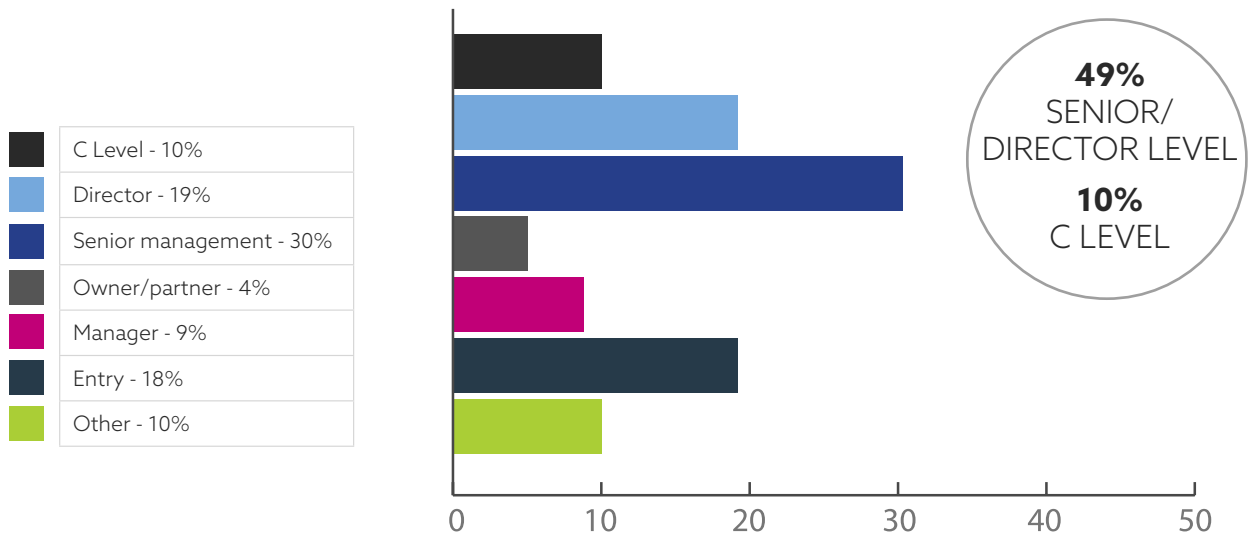


Web Traffic Growth 2022 vs 2021**

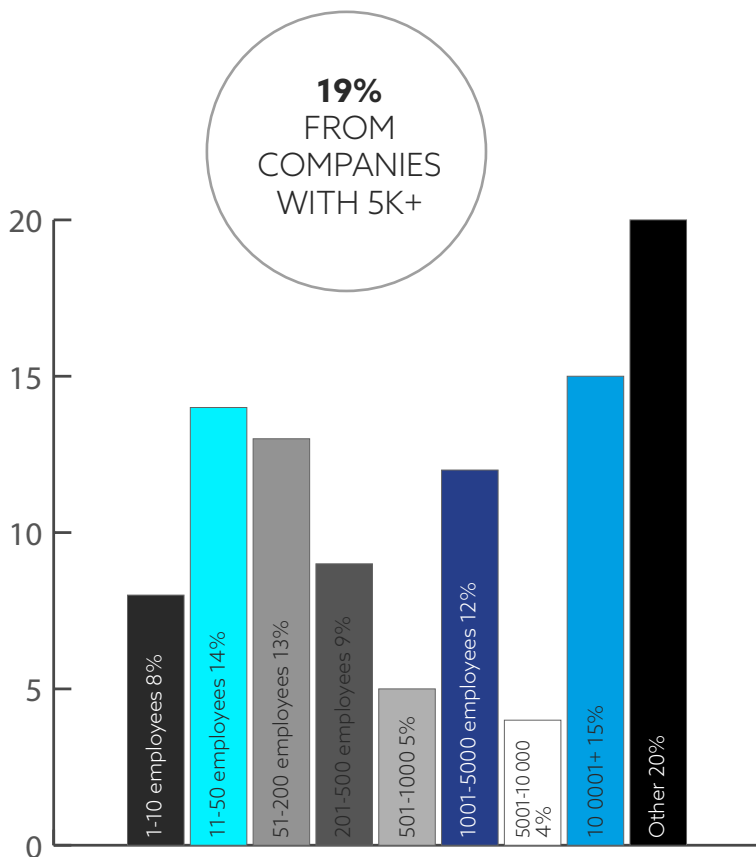

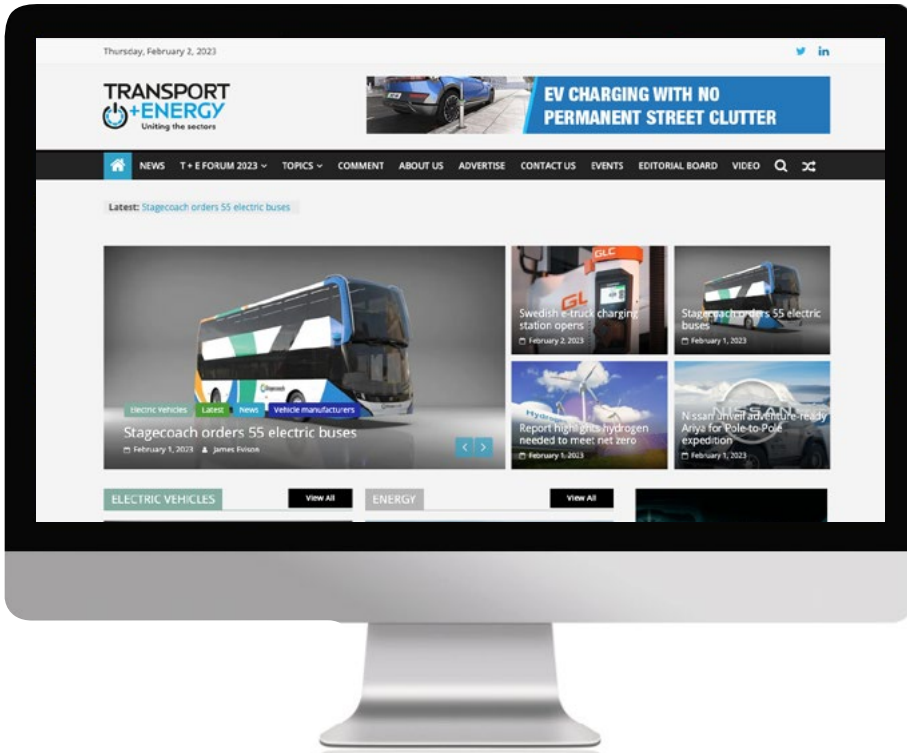
